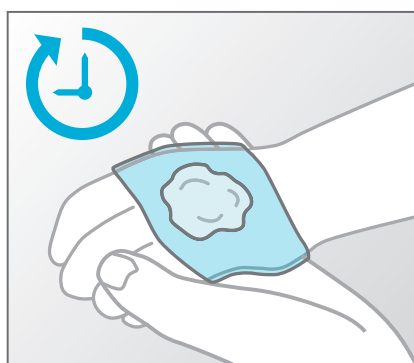
- ▶ Numit 5% cream is an anaesthetic that contains 2.5% lidocaine (lignocaine) and 2.5% prilocaine.

## Dosage and administration.<sup>1</sup>



- ▶ Adults: A thick layer of cream – approximately 1.5g over 10cm<sup>2</sup> of skin for most procedures – should be applied to the desired area about one hour prior to any procedure and covered with an occlusive dressing.
- ▶ Amounts may vary depending on the procedure – see carton insert for specific instructions.
